### **Rev. Dr. Darryl Allen**

Darryl is a native of Greeneville, Tennessee. He graduated from South Greene High School in 1978 and holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Pastoral Ministry from Mid-America Christian University, a Master of Science Degree in Community Agency Counseling from the University of Tennessee, and a Doctor of Ministry Degree in Pastoral Ministry from Winebrenner Theological Seminary.

Darryl's ministry of forty years began when he felt the divine call of God upon his life at the early age of 14. Since then he has served as an evangelist for youth camps, youth retreats, local church revivals and campmeetings. He has pastored for 24 years in Tennessee, Oklahoma, Kentucky and Ohio as well as served six and a half years as the Director of Church Relations at Mid-America Christian University, four years as the Kentucky Regional Pastor and currently is serving as the Regional Field Gifts Officer for Church of God Ministries, Anderson, IN.

He has served on the Executive Council of the Church of God in Tennessee, the State Board Evangelism in Kentucky, the Board of Church Growth in Ohio, and the Oklahoma State Board of Church Extension. He has held several positions in the district fellowships of the Church of God in Tennessee and Kentucky. He is a former member of the Board of Trustees of Mid-America Christian University and was a member of the Select Committee on Credentials for the Church of God, Anderson, IN. He has served as an Adjunct Professor at Mid-America Christian University, Ohio Christian University, Nazarene Bible College and Indiana Wesleyan University. Currently, he serves on the Steering Committee of the Pastors' Fellowship that meets annually in Winchester, Kentucky.

He is married to the former Susan Leigh Pierce of Beaver, Oklahoma. They were united in marriage on June 5, 1981. Susan is a wife, mother, nana and an accomplished soloist. She is a licensed Cosmetologist and has served as a Church Office Secretary, Choir Director and Worship Leader. She holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Behavioral Science from Mid-America Christian University and currently is the Business Degree Faculty Coordinator for Ohio Christian University.

His family includes two daughters, Marisa Allen, age 34, the mother of three children, Andrew Thomas 11, Conner Ray 9 and Kayden Dean 6 and resides in Noble, OK.
