# Pollock Campground Association Covid-19 Guidelines for 2021 Camps

## Screening:

- Students/Counselors/Staff should be screened for temperature and other Covidrelated symptoms before, and upon, arrival to Camp Pollock.
- Anyone displaying symptoms before traveling to Camp Pollock will not be allowed to attend.
- Anyone displaying symptoms upon arrival shall be quarantined until arrangements can be made for their return home.
  - This includes those who may have ridden with someone who is displaying symptoms.
- <sup>-</sup> Temperature and symptom checks are recommended to occur daily.
- Counselors/staff should take special note to be aware of anyone exhibiting symptoms through the duration of camp.
  - <sup>-</sup> If someone begins exhibiting symptoms, they are to be quarantined until arrangements can be made for their return home.

## **Face Coverings:**

 CDC Approved face coverings, covering both the nose and mouth, are encouraged to be worn at all times while indoors.

## **Social Distancing:**

- Individuals should do their best to keep 3 feet of separation between other individuals at all times.
  - Except for members of the same household or static group.

#### Vaccine:

 All those who have been vaccinated with the Covid-19 Vaccine should follow latest CDC guidelines.

## **Hygiene:**

 Hand washing, cough etiquette, cleanliness, and sanitations should be rigorously practiced at all times.

# **Static Groups:**

- It is encouraged for students/counselors/staff to be organized into cohorts in order to ensure lowest chances of cross contamination.
  - Every effort should be made to keep students/counselors/staff from the same areas/churches in the same cohort.
  - <sup>-</sup> These cohorts should remain the same for the duration of the camp.

## **Dining Hall:**

- Entering and exiting the Dining Hall shall occur from the front door only.
- Face Coverings and Social Distancing are encouraged at all times unless seated and eating.
- Food shall be served. NO buffet. No more than 5 food items shall be assigned to each server.
- Social distancing should be practiced between each server.
- Social distancing should be practiced between each person in line.
- Students/Counselors/Staff should be seated with their cohort only.
- <sup>-</sup> 1 person in bathroom at a time.

#### Cleaning:

- Thorough cleaning of tables/chairs shall occur after each usage.
- Door handles to front doors and bathrooms shall be cleaned before and after every meal.
- Bathrooms shall be cleaned before and after every meal.
- Kitchen/serving counter shall be cleaned after every meal.

#### **Games:**

- Social Distancing guidelines should be practiced at all times.
- Games are encouraged to be held only within the assigned cohorts.
- Items used (balls, bats, etc...) shall be cleaned between each usage of different cohorts.

#### **Swimming:**

- It is encouraged for swimming to occur within assigned cohorts only.
- Social distancing guidelines should be practiced at all times, whether inside or outside of the pool.

#### **Tabernacle:**

- Entering and exiting the Tabernacle shall occur from the front door only, unless during an emergency.
- Face Coverings and Social Distancing are encouraged.
- <sup>-</sup> 1 person allowed in the bathroom at a time.
- Seating should occur within the assigned cohorts.
  - With space between each cohort.

- Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 250 or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

#### Worship:

- Performers should be at least 20 feet from attendees.
- Distancing of 6'x6' should be made for each performers.

#### Cleaning:

- Thorough cleaning of tables/chairs shall occur after each service.
- Door handles to front doors and bathrooms shall be cleaned before and after each service.
- Bathrooms shall be cleaned before and after each service.

#### **Children's Building:**

- Entering and exiting the building shall occur from the front door only.
- Face Coverings and Social Distancing are encouraged.
- <sup>-</sup> 1 person allowed in the bathroom at a time.
- Seating should occur within the assigned cohorts.
  - With space between each cohort.
- Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 36 or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

## **Missionary Cottage:**

#### Conference Room:

- Entering and exiting the building shall occur from the front door only.
- Face Coverings and Social Distancing are encouraged.
- $\bar{\ }$  1 person allowed in the bathroom at a time.
- Seating should occur within the assigned cohorts.
  - With space between each cohort.
- Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 30 or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

# Sleeping Quarters (2 Rooms):

- Only available for members of the same family.
- Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 4 people/room or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

## Cleaning:

- Thorough cleaning of room(door knobs, floor, etc...) should occur daily.

- Bathroom should be thoroughly cleaned daily.

#### **Youth Building:**

- Entering and exiting the building shall occur from the front door only.
- Face Coverings and Social Distancing are encouraged.
- <sup>-</sup> 1 person allowed in the bathroom at a time.
- Seating should occur within the assigned cohorts.
  - With space between each cohort.
- Occupancy for per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 89 or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

#### **Pop Stand:**

- Servers should wear proper face coverings as well as gloves at all times.
- <sup>-</sup> 1 person should be designated to only handle money.
- If using multiple lines, there should be 6 feet between each lines.
  - <sup>-</sup> Those in line should practice social distancing at all times.
- Occupancy inside serving area per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 8 or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

# Quads/Building #23,24,30,31 (1 building/4 rooms):

- When sleeping on bunks, every effort should be made to keep social distancing.
  - Head to toe sleeping should be utilized.
- Each person should keep personal items organized and in determined space.
- Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 10 people/room or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

# Bathroom Usage:

- <sup>-</sup> 1 person allowed in bathroom area at a time.
- Each person should use personal hygiene items only (towels, soaps, shampoos, etc...).
  - Hygiene items should be stored with other personal items when not in use.

#### Cleaning:

- <sup>-</sup> Thorough cleaning of room(door knobs, floor, etc...) should occur daily.
- Bathroom should be thoroughly cleaned daily.

# Joy Building #20,32,33:

- When sleeping on bunks, every effort should be made to keep social distancing.
  - Head to toe sleeping should be utilized.
- <sup>-</sup> Each person should keep personal items organized and in determined space.

Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 20 people/room or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

#### Bathroom Usage:

- <sup>-</sup> 1 person allowed in bathroom area at a time.
- Each person should use personal hygiene items only (towels, soaps, shampoos, etc...).
  - Hygiene items should be stored with other personal items when not in use.

#### Cleaning:

- Thorough cleaning of room(door knobs, floor, etc...) should occur daily.
- Bathroom should be thoroughly cleaned daily.

#### **Building #25,29:**

- When sleeping on bunks, every effort should be made to keep social distancing.
  - Head to toe sleeping should be utilized.
- Each person should keep personal items organized and in determined space.
- Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 26 people/room or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

#### Bathroom Usage:

- <sup>-</sup> 1 person allowed in bathroom area at a time.
- Each person should use personal hygiene items only (towels, soaps, shampoos, etc...).
  - Hygiene items should be stored with other personal items when not in use.

# Cleaning:

- Thorough cleaning of room(door knobs, floor, etc...) should occur daily.
- Bathroom should be thoroughly cleaned daily.

# Family Cabins/Building #36,37,38,39 (1 building/4 rooms):

- Only available for members of the same family.
- Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 7 people/room or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

## Cleaning:

- Thorough cleaning of room(door knobs, floor, etc...) should occur daily.
- Bathroom should be thoroughly cleaned daily.

#### Cooks' Cabin:

- Only available for members of the same family.

 Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 16 people or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

#### Cleaning:

- <sup>-</sup> Thorough cleaning of room(door knobs, floor, etc...) should occur daily.
- Bathroom should be thoroughly cleaned daily.

#### **Kid's Place:**

- Only available for members of the same family.
- Occupancy per <u>opensafely.la.gov</u> guidelines(1person/30sq.ft.) is 10 people or whatever is determined using social distancing measures.

# Cleaning:

- Thorough cleaning of room(door knobs, floor, etc...) should occur daily.
- Bathroom should be thoroughly cleaned daily.
